Major Grants to Non-Profit Organizations

Major grants of over \$2000 are awarded annually in the Fall to non-profit organizations to support public humanities projects. Major grant applicants must register their Intent to Apply online by September 1. Major grants support humanities research and content development (i.e., planning and script development) for live public programs as well as media programs up to \$5000. Funds can also support technical assistance for development of humanities resources and archives as well as the production of live public programs and media programs. Project formats include (but are not limited to): talks and lectures, historical dramatizations, panel discussions, book or film discussions, workshops, museum interpretations and public exhibits, oral histories, Teacher Institutes and the development of educational materials, documentary films, and radio programs.

Monthly Mini Grants to Non-Profit Organizations

Mini grants up to \$2000 are awarded on a monthly basis to non-profit organizations to support public humanities programs. Applications are to be completed online and submitted by or on the 1st of each month. Please contact grants staff prior to submitting an application to discuss availability of funds.

Monthly Mini Grants to Individual Researchers

Mini grants up to \$2000 are awarded on a monthly basis to individual researchers to support research in the humanities. Applications are to be completed online and submitted by or on the 1st of each month. Please contact grants staff prior to submitting an application to discuss availability of funds.

Special Initiative Grants

Special Initiative grants support both major and mini grant projects that are inspired by and respond to criteria deriving from the Council's Area of Inquiry theme.
