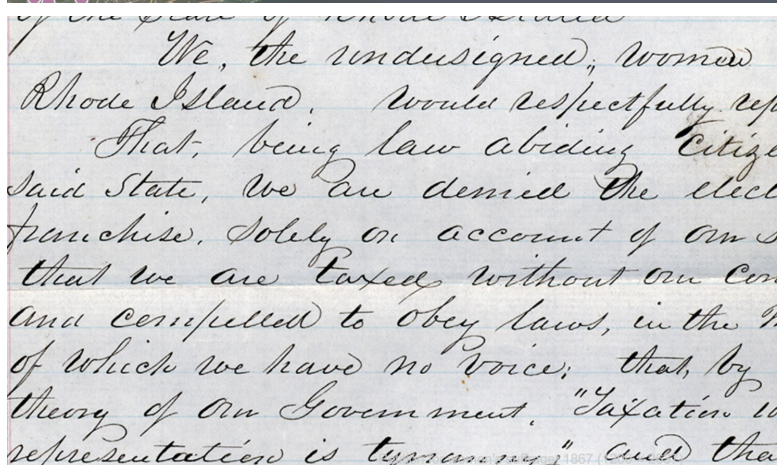
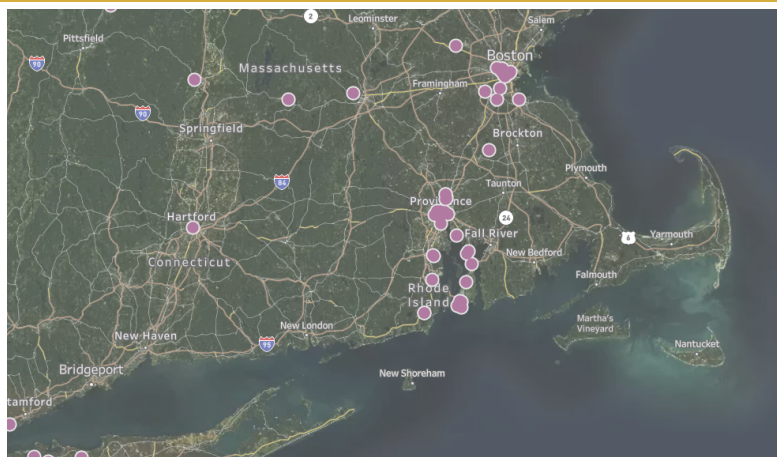
EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS
